# **BANGOR - PEN ARGYL - NAZARETH Adult Education**

## **INFORMATION**

**FREE** Adult Education classes of the Bangor, Pen Argyl, and Nazareth Adult Education program will begin in January 2018. The GED preparation class will help students improve computer skills, reading, writing and math skills to then advance to take the GED test. Students must attend class both days of the first week for assessment and orientation. If a student is not able to begin in January, there will be a class beginning in the middle of February and again in mid-March. Bring a Pennsylvania photo ID to register.

The **Bangor** area GED preparation class will meet in the library of DeFranco Elementary School on Five Points Richmond Rd, Bangor from 6 pm to 8:30 pm on Mondays and Wednesdays. This class begins Monday, January 8. Weather will determine the start dates for February and March.

The **Pen Argyl** area GED class will meet in the Pen Argyl Senior High School Library. This class will run from 6 pm to 8:30 pm on Mondays and Thursdays. This class begins Monday, January 8. Weather will determine the start dates for February and March.

The **Nazareth** area GED class will meet in the lower level of the Nazareth Senior High School Library. The nights for the Nazareth classes are Tuesday and Thursday, from 6 to 8:30 pm, and will begin Tuesday, January 30. Weather will determine the start dates for February and March.

The sessions will run until the middle of May and new classes will begin in September. The 35 year old program has helped many area students earn a GED. Students, who pass the GED, attend class and complete certain requirements, may receive an equivalency high school diploma.

The program is mostly funded by federal and state education grants managed by Northampton Community College. NCC operates one of Pennsylvania's largest Adult Literacy programs serving hundreds of students each year. Funding is also provided by Bangor, Pen Argyl and Nazareth school districts. In addition to these classes, information about continuing studies at NCC will be available.
